

## **Will everyone be saved?**

Devotion and Discussion Guide for Homes and Small Groups

March 25-26, 2006

1. Read Psalm 107:1-3, 17-22 again. What does the Psalmist say is a reason for thanksgiving (vs. 21)? What does it mean to you to be “saved”?
2. Talk with the people in your household or small group about your spiritual journey. How did you come to be a Christian? Where are you now in your relationship with God?
3. Read over Ephesians 2:1-10. It says in vs. 8, “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and it is not your own doing; it is the gift of God...” Faith is a gift of God. Is faith given to everyone? Why or why not?
4. Read John 3:14-21. Go back and read again John 3:16-17. How do you respond to the question, “Will everyone be saved?” What about those who do not know Jesus Christ? Is Jesus necessary? Why?
5. What other questions come to mind as you discuss the question, “Will everyone be saved?” Please share these with the Pastors and others.
6. Whom do you think of when John 3 talks about the “world”?
7. Pray for God’s saving grace and love to come to all people through faith in Jesus Christ.
